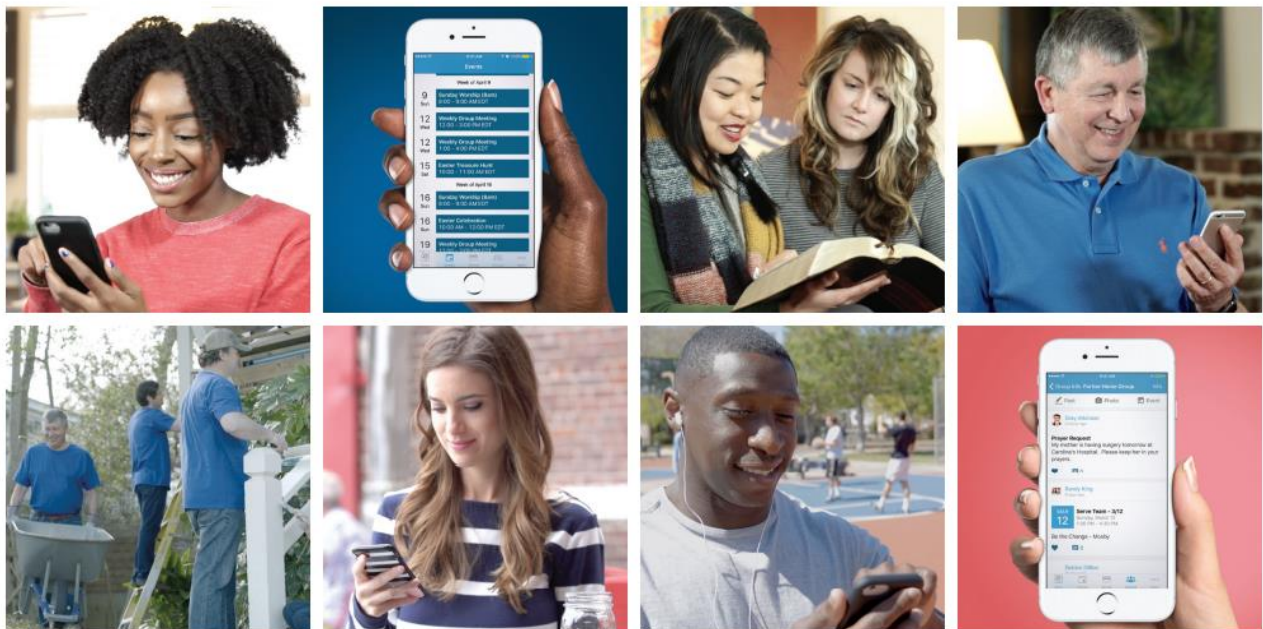


Mission Presbytery is Upgrading from ACS Church Life to Realm® Connect
