JOB DESCRIPTION

REGULAR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide music appropriate for Sunday morning worship services at the direction of the Pastor.
- Work in collaboration with volunteer musicians in the church for special music on Sundays and other services.
- Prepare music for high Holy Days and community services which includes but is not limited to: Advent/Christmas Services, Holy Week Services (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter), and Thanksgiving Service with HHUMC *as needed*.
- Collaborate with Media/AV Tech for Sunday worship and special events.
- Attend monthly Worship Committee Meeting *as needed*.

ONGOING EXPECTATIONS

- Ensure all music used and kept follows all copyright and licensing laws.
- Maintain peak functionality for pianos including regular maintenance (scheduling of tuning, etc.)
- Maintain workable spaces in sanctuary, sacristy, narthex and choir room as per the standards of the Worship and Administrative Committees.
- Holds right of refusal for weddings and funerals on the FHPC campus.
- Finding volunteer substitutes (compensated by Forest Hills) if absent from a Sunday service or special service.
